What is Nordjobb?

- Nordic work exchange program, since 1985
- Offers summerjobs in all the Nordic countries for young people between 18 and 28 years
- Assists in finding accommodation and with practical things like taxes
- Organize freetime activities
- Main financers are the Nordic Council of Ministries, Nordic governments and Nordic associations

Who can apply?

- Citizens of Nordic and EU countries
- Between 18 to 28 years
- Basic knowledge of some Nordic language

Annually around 750 people get a job,
200-300 are Finnish

Around 50 people come to work in
Finland

What kind of jobs?

Traditional summerjobs;

- farming
- hotel/hostel
- Cleaning
- Factory
- Nursing
- Gardening

What is the aim of Nordjobb?

- To increase the mobility of young Nordic people and to increase the knowledge of the Nordic countries
- To strengthen the co-operation in the Nordic labour market
- -> this is a perfect opportunity for employers to have Nordic co-operation

Future plans?

- To have both summerjobs and internships
- To have minor projects inside Nordjobb, for example to help unemployed people to the labour market

How can we develop young people's opportunities for work in the Nordic countries?

- The Nordjobb brand is strong but to function even better it requires understanding of the value of Nordic co-operation and the Nordic languages
